June 29, 2010, Eugene, Oregon—The artwork of 52 sixth grade students from O'Hara Catholic School will be featured at an opening art show on Friday, July 2nd, during the First Friday Artwalk. The artwork is part of an Envision Eugene art project in which three Eugene schools participated.

Envision Eugene is a City of Eugene program that opens dialogue between residents, business owners and city planners about the city's future growth. Under the guidance of O'Hara Art Teacher Anna Mueller, O'Hara's sixth grade students created pen and ink drawings that colorfully depicted their ideas.
